



## LANDSCAPING COMMITTEE

Cordillera's Landscaping Advisory Committee was established in August of 2004. The members of this committee were volunteers appointed by the Cordillera Metropolitan District (CMD) board to represent Cordillera Property Owners' interest and concerns to work with CMD on budget, long range planning, consistency of quality, and to make recommendations to the CMD Board on the operation and budget.

The Landscaping Committee developed a 5-year plan/forecast for all community maintained gardens. Planting philosophy – “The beds should be pretty, with lots of color, tending towards formal without flowers planted in rows. The areas of Cordillera that are not planted should remain natural.”

The Committee consists of the Director of Community Operations, CMD Board representatives and eight (8) property owners with representation from each of the areas – Divide, Ranch and Summit.
